The *Belle* Coco Republic Interior Designer of the Year will also receive a \$2500 voucher from Parisi and return flights for two to attend Maison&Objet Paris.

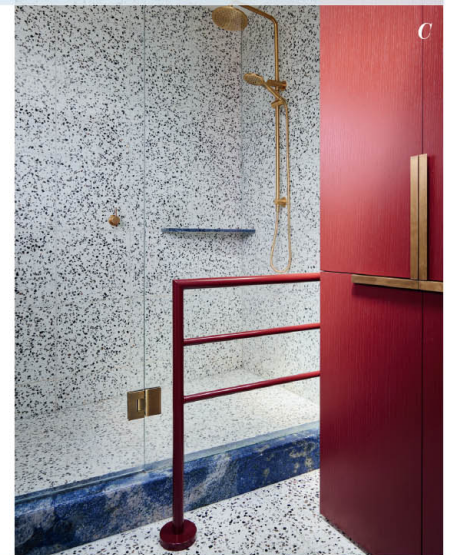
